RUBB GO TO ANY LENGTHS FOR OFFSHORE INDUSTRY

Subsea 7's base at Wick in Scotland has just taken delivery of another of Rubb's THA Shelters. This now provides Subsea 7 with one continuous completed shelter of over 150m (492') in length, the longest of its type that Rubb has ever produced.



“As we manufacture lengths of pipe for the offshore industry it is vital that we can continue this process all year round and in the worst of weathers” commented Subsea 7's Site Purchasing Sup, Tom Cowie. “We have now bought eight completed THA sections in the last seven years from Rubb and we are delighted with the service” he continued. “The fact that Rubb THA shelters come in modular

lengths of 3 meters (10') allows us to continue the extension of our existing fabrication shop quickly and economically.”

The THA Shelters provided to Subsea 7 come in 12 meter (39.4') spans; however this specific design is also available in 6m (19.7'), 8m (26.2') and 10m (32.8') spans.
